SUBJECT: Report on Bids and Construction Contract Award for Montague Expressway Pavement Rehabilitation Project (Phase 3), Federal Project Number ESPL-5937(132)

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Accept Report on Bids for construction of Montague Expressway Pavement Rehabilitation Project (Phase 3), Federal Project Number ESPL-5937(132).

Possible action:

- a. Award contract to Granite Construction Company in the amount of \$2,819,059 with a construction time of fifty (50) working days.
- b. Approve Request of Appropriation Modification No. 201 - \$3,054,000 increasing revenue and expenditures in the Roads and Airports budget. (4/5 roll call vote)

- c. Authorize the Director, Roads and Airports Department, to issue Change Orders as necessary against the allowance for Supplemental Work and to approve modifications to the construction time.

- d. Ratify Addendum No. 1.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There is no impact to the County General Fund. The Appropriation Modification (F-85) budgets \$3,054,000 of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funding for the project in Road Fund account 603 -62902-0020, Montague Expressway.

CONTRACT HISTORY

On March 24, 2009, the Board approved the project, adopted the plans and specifications, and authorized staff to advertise the project for bids contingent upon approval from Caltrans to proceed with construction. The Department received Caltrans' approval to advertise the project for construction on May 12, 2009 and subsequently scheduled the bid opening for June 4, 2009.

This is a Type I service contract subject to the Resolution of Contracting Principles adopted by the Board of Supervisors on October 28, 1997. The Contracting Principles are included in the Special Provisions of the Contract Documents.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

This project is part of the federal economic stimulus program created by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). The contract provides for pavement repair and overlay on sections of Montague Expressway from Hwy. 101 to Mission Boulevard, Plumeria/Zanker Road to Hwy. 880, and Capitol Avenue to Hwy. 680, thereby completing the rehabilitation of the entire length of Montague Expressway from Hwy. 101 to Hwy. 680.

On June 4, 2009, six bids were received as follows:

6. C. F.Archibald Paving, Inc.	\$3,058,136.50

The low base bid was submitted by Granite Construction Company in the amount of \$2,819,059.00 (including supplemental work allowance), which is 3.70% lower than the Engineer's estimate. The Department has reviewed the bids, found all to be responsive, and recommends awarding the contract to the low bidder, Granite Construction Company, in the amount of \$2,819,059.00.

The contract Special Provisions require paving work to be performed at night to reduce traffic impacts. The night work entails some unavoidable noise impacts.

One (1) addendum was issued during the course of bidding for this contract to specify the requirements related to the state-promulgated Race Conscious (RC) Underutilized Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (UDBE) program applicable to all federally-funded contracts awarded after June 2, 2009. In order to formally incorporate the addendum into the bid documents, the Department recommends that the Board ratify this addendum.

The low bidder proposes to utilize UDBE subcontractors at an estimated percentage of 3%. The County's Department of Equal Opportunity has reviewed the bidder's documentation and approves the 3% UDBE project participation.

CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION

The contract will not be awarded and construction of the project will not proceed.

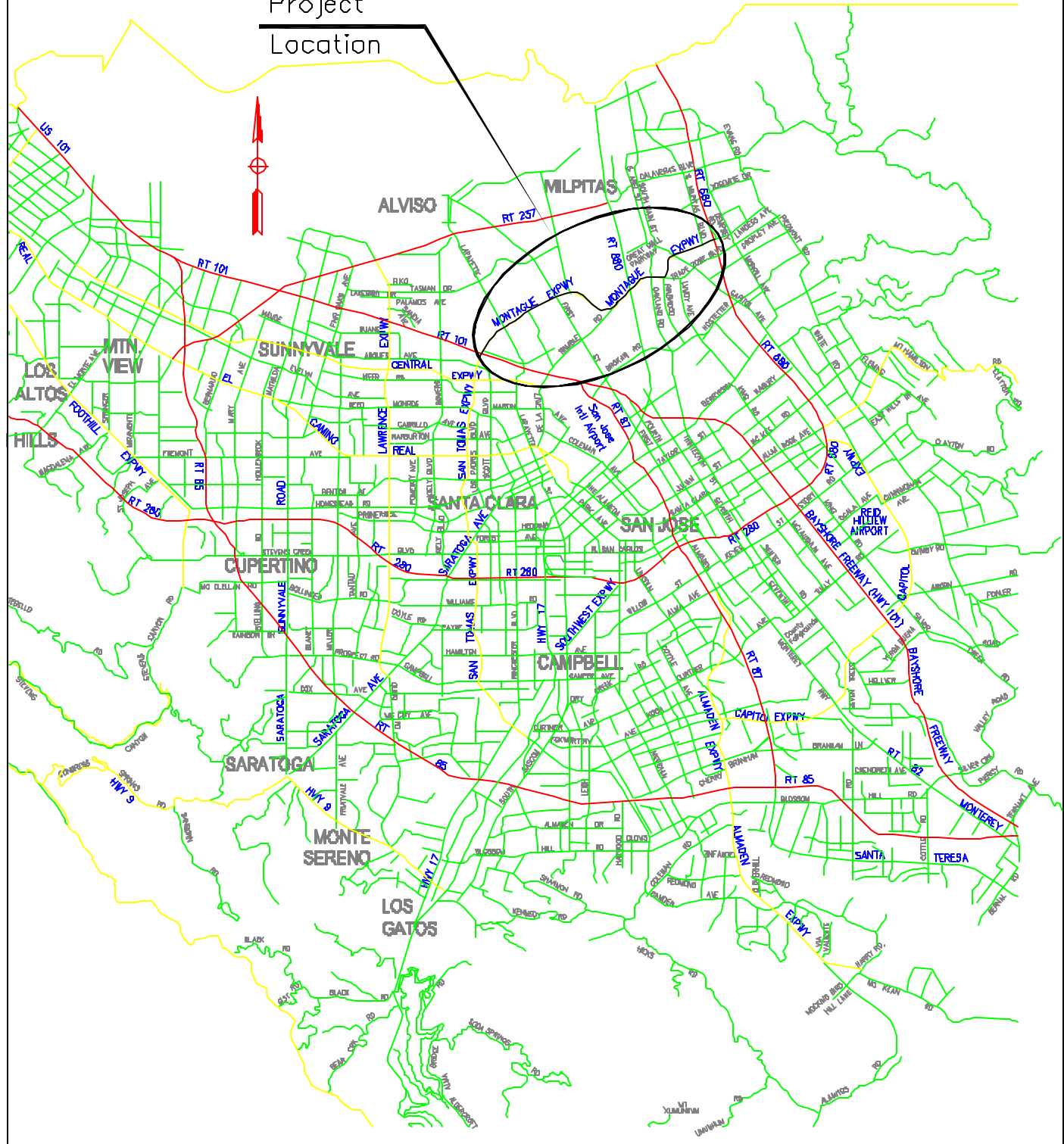
