Dear Mr. Secretary:

Pursuant to Section 1526 of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (Pub. L. 111-5 [February 17, 2009]) (ARRA), I hereby certify that the County of Santa Clara's request for infrastructure investment under the DOE Energy Independence and Security Act (EISA) has received the full review and vetting required by law and I accept responsibility that the infrastructure investment is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars.

The County of Santa Clara seeks \$176,000 in Federal funds for the Santa Clara County Plug In Electric Drive Program. Total program investment is \$352,000; the County will provide a 50% match toward the costs.

The program would fund installation of electric vehicle charging stations at four County campus locations and each charging station would be accessible to the public.
